Launching

In March of 2021 the MyPlace house was dedicated after a complete remodel and raising our first year of operational funding. By April we hired our staff and volunteers and accepted our first resident! To date we have trained over 35 staff and volunteers.



All 9 residents have been provided case management and necessary medical care and four of our residents have received assistance in obtaining State IDs. In our home, residents are learning to practice conflict resolution which aids in healthy relationships and communication.



Five of our residents attended High school in 2021, one of which graduated high school while staying in the home. We work hand in hand with residents to complete school work, practice interviewing skills, and write resumes.



Our community has been a blessing to our work. Four church groups helped work on our house, over ten businesses have supported us financially, five organizations have supported us in the media, and many individuals volunteer their time and finances - all of which are highly valued at MyPlace!



Seven of our nine residents were employed while staying with us. We assist residents with transportation and navigating the challenges encountered while employed.



Adjustments and growth continue to make us more effective in serving our young women. We continue to assess and adjust staffing, our intake processes, communal living agreements, transportation needs, and many aspects of our programming.


At MyPlace we never lose sight of the fact that each youth we seek to serve is an individual. Each has their own unique story and history. Each with their own potential to thrive and excel in life.
